Langmore 2.0: Advanced FEES Course

Purpose:

This course is designed for SLPs who are FEES competent (performing FEES independently) who want to sharpen their scoring and interpretation of FEES exams. Updates in research, FEES protocols, and scoring methods will be reviewed. A review of optimal scoping techniques will be reviewed to ensure participants can achieve optimal views. Participants will have an opportunity to sharpen their skills by practicing scoring recorded FEES exams and by calibrating their scoring and interpretation with course faculty and with other participants. Many case studies will be provided for training purposes and to facilitate discussion in this interactive course.

Learning Outcomes:

1. Be familiar with the latest research and clinical updates
2. Administer a FEES protocol that is best suited for the patient
3. Score a FEES exam using standard scoresheet
4. Interpret abnormal findings from a study
5. Use appropriate treatment techniques using FEES
6. Be aware of optimal endoscopy techniques
7. Apply FEES to different settings
