

## Langmore FEES Introductory Scope Passing and Scoring Course

### Course description:

This training will provide clinicians with a basic level of competence with handling the endoscope, passing it into the hypopharynx, manipulating the scope within and around the larynx to attain an optimal view, and to apply aspects of the Langmore FEES protocol to procedure. The course will entail an overview and demonstration of how to use the endoscopy equipment, followed by mentored hands-on practice performing the FEES procedure on each other in a small group setting. Additional training in FEES scoring will also be provided.

### Learning objectives:

- ❖ Demonstrate how to properly handle and manipulate an endoscope during a FEES exam.
- ❖ Demonstrate how to manipulate the scope within and around the larynx to attain an optimal view.
- ❖ Describe nasal, pharyngeal, and laryngeal anatomy relevant to performing and interpreting a FEES exam.
- ❖ Apply the Langmore FEES protocol when performing and reviewing FEES exams.
